Present Simple Tense

a) We use the present simple tense to talk about an action that is done often or every day.

Subject + verb + object		
I You We They	like	swimming.
He She It Hani	likes	swimming.

b) We use the present simple tense to state a fact.

Giraffes	live	in Africa.
Giraffe	lives

Present Continuous Tense



We use the present continuous tense:

- to talk about an action happening at the moment.
- to talk about a continuous action happening at this time but not necessarily at the exact time of speaking.

Subject + am/is/are/+ verb-ing + ...

I	am playing	hockey now.
He	is playing
