



Present Perfect + Ever



Present Perfect + ever

To ask questions about someone's experiences.

Examples:

- "Have you **ever** taken mountain climbing classes?"
"Yes, I have."
- "Has he **ever** been involved in any accident?"
"No, he hasn't."
- "Have your friends **ever** seen you doing gymnastics?"
"Yes, they have!"

Only use "ever" in a question form.

Present Perfect + never

To talk about things you have not done at any time in your life.

Examples:

- I've **never** swum with the dolphins. I've always wanted to try!
- Isa has **never** heard of Tony Hawk. He is a professional skateboarder.
- Devi has **never** tried parachuting. She's afraid of heights.
- They have **never** been to other parts of the world.
- Alia has **never** been to Canada. She will fly there this weekend.
